- Spot Checks
  - Carrying out line checks on filled finished products, checking packaging, labelling, batch coding, weights and general appearance are all correct.
  - Ensuring finished goods retain samples are taken
  - Checking and Maintaining Quality Control records
  - Ensuring a high level of Quality Control is maintained at all times and that all procedures are being adhered to in factory areas
  - Undertaking Q/C checks, ensuring accurate records.
  - Raising issues found to QC technologists and QC supervisor to enable further investigation.
  - Calibration and functional checks on scales
- AQL Checks
  - Carrying out statistical sampling and quality checks on finished products. Accurately recording and photographing results.
  - Ensuring specific customer requirements are met before goods are shipped
  - Ensuring samples are taken for customer approval when required.
